

## GRAMMAR: PRONOUN PREFIXES

### SET "A" PREFIXES: Often used on Action Verbs

<u>First Person</u>	<u>Before Consonants</u>		<u>Before Vowel</u>	
	<u>Prefix</u>	<u>Stem</u>	<u>Prefix</u>	<u>Stem</u>
I	tsi-	wonih-	g-	eg-
I & you	ini-	wonih-	in-	eg-
I & you, she/he	idi-	wonih-	id-	eg-
I & she/he	osdi-	wonih-	osd-	eg-
I & they	otsi-	wonih-	ots	-eg-

<u>Second Person</u>	<u>Before Consonants</u>		<u>Before Vowel</u>	
	<u>Prefix</u>	<u>Stem</u>	<u>Prefix</u>	<u>Stem</u>
You	hi-	wonih-	h-	ega
You 2	sdi-	wonih-	sd-	ega
You 3 or more	itsi-	wonih-	its-	ega

<u>Third Person</u>	<u>Before Consonants</u>		<u>Before Vowel</u>	
	<u>Prefix</u>	<u>Stem</u>	<u>Prefix</u>	<u>Stem</u>
She/he	a-/ or/ ga-	wonih -	-	ega
They	ani-	wonih -	an-	ega

**Note:** Third person 'she/he' before the vowels /o/, /u/, and /v/ use /g-/.

#### **Example:**

gohweli'a > she/he is writing.  
 gudalvsga > she/he is connecting.  
 gvniha > she/he is hitting.

**Before Consonants:** All stems start with a consonant.

**Before Vowel:** All stems begin with a vowel.

## GRAMMAR: PRONOUN PREFIXES

### SET "B" PREFIXES: Often used on Passive/Stative Verbs

<u>First Person</u>	<u>Before Consonants</u>		<u>Before Vowel</u>	
	<u>Prefix</u>	<u>Stem</u>	<u>Prefix</u>	<u>Stem</u>
I	agi-	h-	aqua-	ohiyuhih-
I & you	gini-	h-	gin-	ohiyuhih-
I & you & she/he	igi-	h-	ig-	ohiyuhih-
I & she/he	ogini-	h-	ogin-	ohiyuhih-
I & they	ogi-	h-	og-	ohiyuhih-

<u>Second Person</u>	<u>Before Consonants</u>		<u>Before Vowel</u>	
	<u>Prefix</u>	<u>Stem</u>	<u>Prefix</u>	<u>Stem</u>
You	tsa-	h-	ts-	ohiyuhih-
You 2	sdi-	h-	sd-	ohiyuhih-
You 3 or more	itsi-	h-	its-	ohiyuhih-

<u>Third Person</u>	<u>Before Consonants</u>		<u>Before Vowel</u>	
	<u>Prefix</u>	<u>Stem</u>	<u>Prefix</u>	<u>Stem</u>
She/he	u-	h-	uw-	ohiyuhih-
They	uni-	h-	un-	ohiyuhih-

**Note:** Third Person 'she/he' /u-/ before vowel /a-/ deletes /a/.  
 U-duliha/ 'she wants it.'
